ABOUT THE PROJECT AIM...

THE PROJECT IS FOR THOSE WHO WORK WITH EXCLUDED OR INTERESTED IN WORKING WITH EXCLUDED PEOPLE AND SOCIAL/STREET WORK (ALSO STUDENTS - PREFERABLY PEDAGOGY OR PSYCHOLOGY).

Main objectives of the project:

- exchange of experience, knowledge and information related to the specific problems of excluded people in the countries and methods of solving them as a training background.
- draw attention to how develop smaller cities, where an increasing proportion of the population is made up of ethnic minorities.
- Passing the street work skills as a tool to support excluded people leading to psychosocial development and reducing unemployment.
- implementation of revitalization and city psychology as an important element of work in environments threatened with exclusion.
- focus on the problem of poor youth activity excluded youth centers.
- Participation in conference about streetworking and Study visit in environment and specialized centers where we are working.

The project will enable participants to learn about streetworking in a local and also global context. Participants will learn not only the secrets of streetworking, but also develop solutions for involving young people in social activities. In addition, they will familiarize themselves with theories of city psychology as background training. Participants broaden their knowledge to deepen their personal development and establish new relationships with organizations from all over Europe

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

All costs related to accommodation, and food (3 meals per day “breakfast, lunch, supper”) will be covered by Project budget as well. We will not pay preparation costs for partner organizations since it will be contribution from side of partner organizations as usual in Erasmus Plus training course projects.

Transportation costs of all participants will be covered by project budget up to Erasmus + limits of transportation costs for partner countries (look below).

TRANSPORT METHODS

YOU WILL BE OBLIGATED TO REACH VENUE BY YOURSELF.

1. If you are planning a plane trip best way is reservation zak express bus from Warsaw to Elk. We will help You and prepare all steps. All what You will need it will be a password which You will say for bus driver.
2. If You are planing a bus trip You must send Us where the bus will stop and We will prepare rest of details.
3. If You are planing a car trip You must turn on GPS ;).
How We will count the costs. In Poland all what We can honour it is:
 - a) Business trip by own car = 0,8358 PLN/1 km
ex. Brno-Elk-Brno - 1600 km x 0,8358 pln = 1337,28 pln = 312 EUR
 - b) Invoice (rent a car etc). We can pay As much as your limits are.
