Castelfranco Emilia is a town in Italy in the province of Modena, region of Emilia-Romagna. The town lies about 25 kilometres (16 mi) northwest of Bologna. Castelfranco either occupies or lies near the site of the ancient Forum Gallorum, a place on the Via Aemilia between Modena and Bologna, where in 43 BC Octavian and Hirtius defeated Mark Antony. In 1861 it was joined with the former comune of Piumazzo.

This town is famous for inventing tortellini, a typical Italian food. In this region Lambrusco wine is also produced. The church of Santa Maria Assunta houses a picture of the Assumption of Mary by Guido Reni. Castelfranco has also a fortress built in 1628–34 by Urban VIII as a northern defensive bastion for the Papal States.

HOSTING ORGANIZATION

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The project "World Cup Volunteers 2017" is a Large Scale EVS funded by Erasmus+ programme. It will take place during "Mondiali Antirazzisti 2017" (No racist cup): http://www.mondialiantirazzisti.org/new/?lang=en

This non-competitive sports championship was created in 1997 to fight racial and gender discrimination, promoting the values of sport and multiculturalism. The main aim of the project is to promote active citizenship, social inclusion and solidarity by involving the volunteers in the organization and management of Mondiali Antirazzisti and by promoting volunteering among youths and stakeholders. The project will emphasize the value of peer-to-peer education in promoting healthy lifestyles, as well as highlight the values of anti-discrimination and intercultural dialogue.

Mondiali Antirazzisti has experienced a constant growth in the number of participants and in the 2013 edition over 8,000 people and 200 volunteers from more than 50 nationalities have participated.





DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT — LSEVS PROGRAMME

A Large Scale (EVS) is the Action of Erasmus + programme. The main objective of this project is to support international large-scale volunteering during European or worldwide events. EVS program brings young people from different countries the opportunity to get volunteering experience abroad. During our EVS, we choose to use the self-management method, where participants have to provide themselves to cook food and to prepare and make the activities following the agenda and the predeparture preparation made with the sending partner and the group leader. It means that everybody is involved in the process to create the project, having tasks, responsibilities and rules (that participants decide all together). The activities will be run by the non-formal method (games, role games, team building games etc.) to learn by having fun.

The festival will provide youth with an unique opportunity to be engaged in facilitation of a wide range of different sports activities (football, basketball, volley, rugby, crickets, yoga, gymnastics, etc), workshops for children, different educational and animation activities, debates on antidiscrimination and prejudices, etc. The activities within the festival will foster health and well-being of young people and youth fitness and physical activity; encourage healthy lifestyles for young people via physical education, education on nutrition, physical activity and collaboration between sport organizations; emphasize the role of sport as an activity supporting teamwork, intercultural learning, fair play and responsibility; support development of intercultural awareness and competences for all young people and combat prejudice; enhance intercultural awareness.

WHAT IS VOLUNTEERING IN MONDIALI ANTIRAZZISTI?

« Certainly is an adventure that begins in the beautiful setting of Bosco Albergati under the scorching sun of the two weeks between June and July.

When you arrive at Bosco, the land barren and desolate doesn't let your brain thinking that in a few days there will be a real Festival. With stands, gelateria, restaurant, bar and paninoteca, tents, campers and caravans, number of people incalculable, games, parties, a big stage to host quite famous singers and a club where rock out and make friends.

When you arrive at Bosco, during the first night you will find it hard to believe that you have to spend fifteen days in a large room with other volunteers that you do not even remember the names, without internet, without washing machines or iron with squat toilets and showers in container. When you get to Bosco did not think about how it can be an educational experience.

AGENDA OF THE PROJECT





Activities and attitude: The volunteers will take part to the whole organisation and to the implementation of the festival, in particular in logistics and practical aspects (cleaning, helping in the kitchen, arranging festival spaces). They will have the possibility to take part to various activities, such as tournaments of several sports, outdoor activities, debates related to antidiscrimination, concerts... The project "World cup volunteers 2015" will also include the following activities:

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be a camping area, in which there is a big shed with cots for volunteers. The shed is divided in two different areas: one for male and one for women. Attached to the sleeping area there are many bathroom containers with toilets and showers. The area is really wide and huge and is totally natural as a camping area should be.

Restaurant area is 300m far from the sleeping area, and is composed by a kitchen that volunteers will use for cooking and a big space with tables and chairs. Usually volunteers eat all together – in the same space. During the festival, volunteers will have a free pass for eating in the restaurants.

LOGISTICAL INFORMATION

Project approach: WCV has reached its 3° edition. The approach of the project is between a volunteering camp and a work camp. It is basically projected together with Mondiali Antirazzisti Festival, which is at its 21° edition. Volunteers should come just if they want to work for the success of this important festival, as they will significant contribute to its realization and their approach and attitude will be very important. Volunteers will have 2 free days in which they can visit some localities, in the other days they have to follow the activities' agenda.

What to bring?

LOGISTICAL INFORMATION — HOW TO ARRIVE

How to arrive: YouNet will organize the transfer from Bologna train station to Castelfranco Emilia. Participants should be at the train station at maximum 17.00.

You arrive by plane to Bologna Airport:

The Airport is about 6 Km far from Bologna city centre.

A shuttle bus links G.Marconi airport to Bologna railway station (<u>Aerobus - BLO</u> shuttle service). A one way ticket costs 6,00€ and can be bought directly on the bus. The bus stops for taking the shuttle are

- at the airport: at the car park next to Terminal A exit (on your right)
- at the Bologna railway station (next to the exit).

Departures from the airport are scheduled every 15 minutes.

There are buses from 8.00 am until 00.15.
