SEE, HEAR AND ACT

APV (26. - 27. September 2018)

Youth Exchange (28. October - 3. November 2018) – travel days (27th and 4th)

→ SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

»See, hear and act« is an international youth exchange which will involve **16 young** participants aged **16-23**, accompanied by four youth leaders. The project includes **4 partners:** Mladinski center Trbovlje (Slovenia), European Association World-our Home (Latvia), Social Youth development civil nonprofit society - K.A.NE. (Greece) and Udruga gluhih i nagluhih Nova Gradiška (Croatia). It will take place in Trbovlje, Slovenia. During 7 days of activities, young participants will explore the world of people with hearing and seeing obstacles through theatre methods.

AIM:

The basic aim of the project is getting to know and understand the life of deaf and blind people through the process of exploring through theatre performance. We will raise awareness and consequently encourage inclusion of people with special needs into everyday activities.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To understand life of deaf and blind people and include people with special needs into everyday activities through various workshops.
- 2. To raise awareness throughought the exchange and final performance about the importance of integration of the deaf and blind people among people in the local community.
- 3. Intercultural awareness to encourage tolerance and learning about other cultures through various workshops that will be contributed by partner organizations.

Results of the project:

- 1 final performance
- 1 video of the performance
- 1 questionnaire for the visitors of the performance, later analyzed and sent to organizations that deal with theathre and performance

→ PARTICIPANTS

Each partner organization will have 5 paticipants: 1 youth leader (over 18) and 4 young persons aged from 16 to 23. The planned male/female ratio is 50:50. Each partner will also

have at least **2 young participants with less opportunities** (with social, cultural or economic obstacles). We ask all the partnes to have the <u>signed consents of the parents</u> of the young participants under 18.

APV:

Each partner provides 1 youth leader (over 18) and 1 young participant aged 16 to 23 (that will later on participate also on the exchange).

→FINANCE

Maximum dotation for travel cost for Greek organization is 275 € per person, maximum dotation for Latvian organization is 275 € per person and maximum dotation for Croatian organization is 180 €.

In case one of the partners rightfully exceeds the agreed maximum amount, the applicant has the right to redistribute the unused funds between the partners. The payment for travel costs of the APV will be made immediately after signing the agreement and received travel documentation. Any additional expenses (health insurance for the participants etc.) have to be covered by the partners themselves. Partners will receive 100 % of the actual travel costs on the basis of original tickets sent to the applicant.

Each partner also has up to 50 € available budget for the purpose of multicultural evening. We will discuss the details on the APV.

→ APV ACTIVITIES:

Advanced planning visit is planned for 26th and 27th of September (25th and 28th are travel days).

- 1. Getting to know each other (each partner presents their country, their city, their orgnization and themselves) and teambuilding games.
- 2. Presentation of the topic and timetable of the exchange and setting the ground rules.
- 3. Brainstormning on creative methods that will be used on the exchange and dividing the tasks/workshops between partners.
- 4. To make a list of all possible reflexion methods that will be used on the exchange and who will carry out daily reflexions.
- 5. Going through the Partnership Agreement.
- 6. Reflection and evaluation of APV (suggestions for the exchange itself).

→ EXCHANGE ACTIVITIES:

- 1 workshop/activity including people with special needs from local organization
- 3 theathre workshops with different methods (theatre of the oppressed, improvization, dance theatre etc.)
- 2 street actions in the local environment
- 1 international evening with presentation of all partners
- Presentation of the project after the exchange in local community of each partner
- Youthpass workshop

→ VENUE:

All activities will take place in the town of Trbovlje, Slovenia. Participants will stay at Mladinski center Trbovlje, which runs a youth hostel and a cafe (http://mct.si/en/home/). The location is in the center of the town, next to cultural center and cinema, close to shops and library. Participants will be accomodated in the dormitory and 3-bed rooms, divided according to their gender. Dormitory is a 14-bed room with two shared bathrooms and toilets. Smaller rooms have their own bathroom. Bed linen and towels are provided by the hostel. Breakfast and coffee breaks will be provided in the hostel kitchen by MCT staff, lunch and dinner will be organized in the local restaurant. Rooms are covered with free Wi-Fi. A part of the hostel is also a laundry, which participants can use if necessary. Activities will take place in the multipurpose hall of our building.
