WHO?

- 5 countries: Bosnia and Herzegovina, France, Greece, Poland, and Germany
- 7 participants (best: 16-23 years old, max. 26 years old) + 1 group leader (no age limit) per country
- gender balance and participants from rural areas preferred

WHEN?

Arrival | Thursday, 25th April 2019

Departure | Sunday, 5th May 2019

WHAT?

Europe | clichés and stereotypes | creativity | youth participation

The youth exchange “Different than the rest? Our clichés and stereotypes” aims at young people aged 16-23 from five different countries within Europe. We aim at involving young people to think about clichés and stereotypes that they have towards other “groups” – be those “others” the population of other countries, minorities and majorities in their own countries, or just groups of people that are generally understood as one. While talking about stereotypes, they shall reflect upon the process of creating those pictures of others and how these pictures influence our daily lives and behaviours.

The participants will produce the outcomes of their discussions creatively afterwards: in a photography/portrait workshop and one other workshop (to be discussed during APV).

ORGANIZATIONAL DETAILS (for partner organizations)

Advance Planning Visit (APV)

Date | to be decided (25-27 or 27-29 March)

Participants | 1 group leader (and 1 participant of the youth exchange) per country

Aim | get to know each other, develop the schedule of the YE, assignment of tasks and responsibilities

Travel support

ERASMUS+ will pay the travel expenses up to a fixed amount calculated from the distance between the location of the partner organization and the location of the youth exchange (Magdeburg). Travel expenses will be reimbursed for participants and group leaders for the APV and the YE.

The maximum fixed amounts per country are:

- Bosnia and Herzegovina 275,00 € / person
- Greece 275,00 € / person
- France 275,00 € / person
- Poland 180,00 € / person

Please note the following:

- Try to find the most economical way of traveling. | Book the tickets as soon as possible.
- Tickets should be booked by the partner organization.
- To reimburse travel expenses, Bildungsnetzwerk Magdeburg gGmbH needs the ORIGINAL travel documents with date, location (from where to where), name of the traveller and price visible.
- E-Tickets/-Invoices must be accompanied by proof of payment.
- Missing tickets will not be reimbursed.
- Travel expenses will only be reimbursed up to the actual amount payable.

Insurance

Participants need the EU blue card or an equivalent valid insurance card. Please inform your participants about the details of your country!

A group insurance will be taken out by Bildungsnetzwerk Magdeburg gGmbH for the time of the stay of the participants and group leaders.



Participants organize and pay themselves for the travel insurance to take part in the YE!

Participants are responsible to take medication/pills they need with them. Participants have to inform group leaders about illnesses and allergies!

Stay in Magdeburg

All participants and teamers will stay in the city of Magdeburg at Jugendbildungsstaette Ottersleben of the Bildungsnetzwerk Magdeburg gGmbH (shared rooms) and will be fully boarded (vegetarian, vegan food, no pork etc. possible).

Youth protection / Data security

- participants under 18:
 - o Consent form for the parents including photo/video allowance
 - o Partners have to send scans of consent form before arrival and bring originals to the YE (!!)
- participants & team leaders over 18: give photo/video allowance by themselves during the YE
