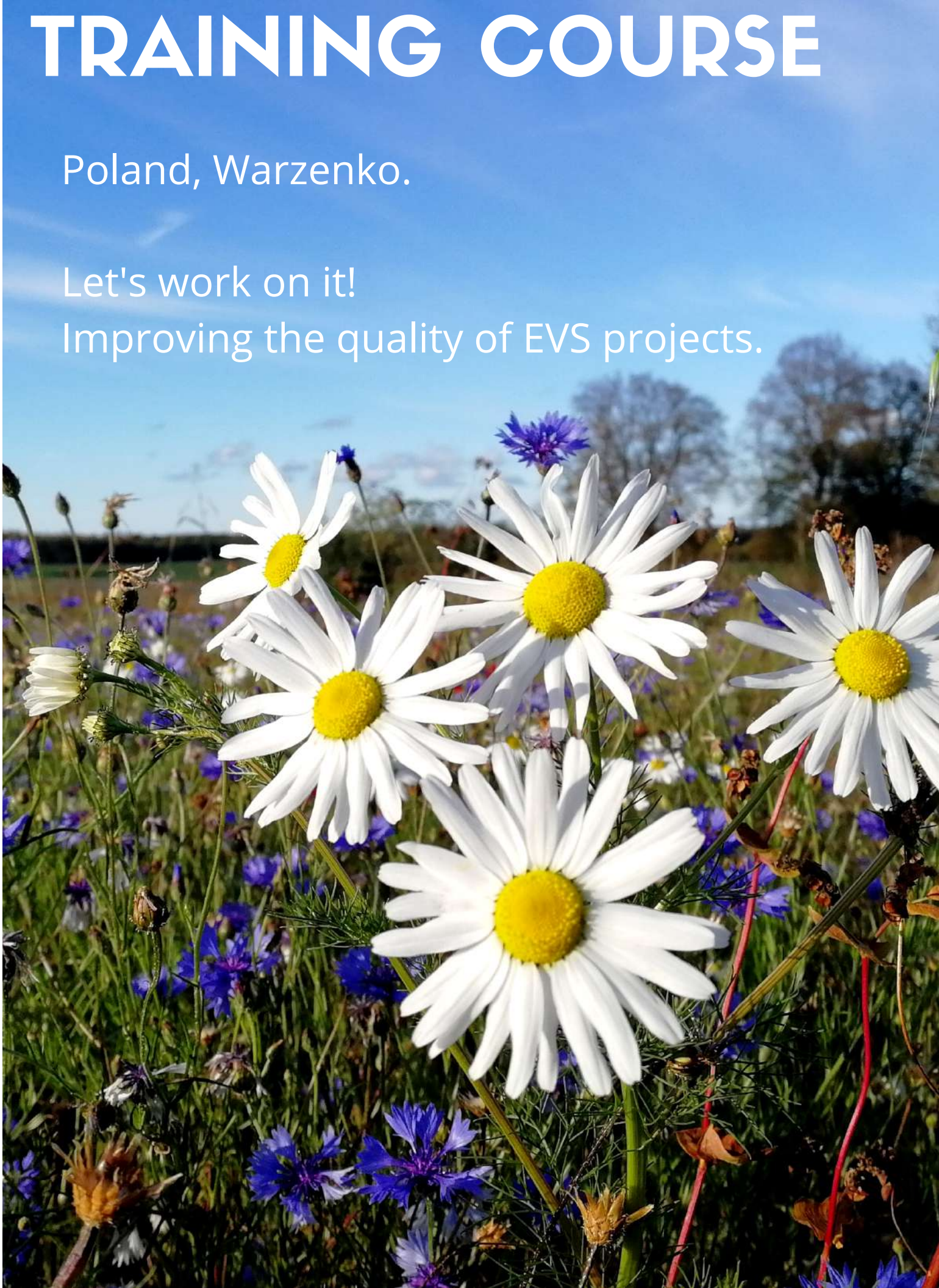

Hello!

We are looking forward to meeting you, in March of 2019, in Poland. We'll provide a training course which topic will be the quality of EVS projects. Here you can find useful, basic information about the event.

The aim of the activity is to improve the quality of European Voluntary Service projects by providing coordinators and mentors with competences that will help them to support volunteers in a more professional way.

During this 5 training days, with the support of 3 experienced facilitators, participants will share their knowledge and experience related to the support of foreign volunteers.


During active workshops in an international environment, they will focus on relevant topics to their roles such as:

- Intercultural environment;
- motivating a volunteer;
- effective communication;
- conflict resolution;
- supporting volunteer's learning process;
- coping with burnout;
- loss of motivation.

FOR WHOM?

The training is addressed to EVS coordinators and mentors with previous experience related to the support of EVS volunteers. The training will be attended by 26 participants representing 19 organizations from 14 countries (including 9 program countries and 5 partner countries). All of the costs (program, food, accommodation) is covered within the program. You will be accommodated in guesthouse "Warzenko" in the small village with the same name.

The cost of transport will be covered after the training up to the following amounts:

360 EUR- Armenia, Georgia, Spain, Portugal;

275 EUR- Ukraine, Moldova, Italy, Romania, Greece, Slovenia, Turkey;

180 EUR- Belarus;

Please remember that travel from Gdansk airport/Gdynia train station to the venue of the training will be also covered from this amounts.

In the case of Belarus, Turkey and Armenia we have some funds to cover visa costs.

The training is organized by **Centre for Youth and Mobility**.
