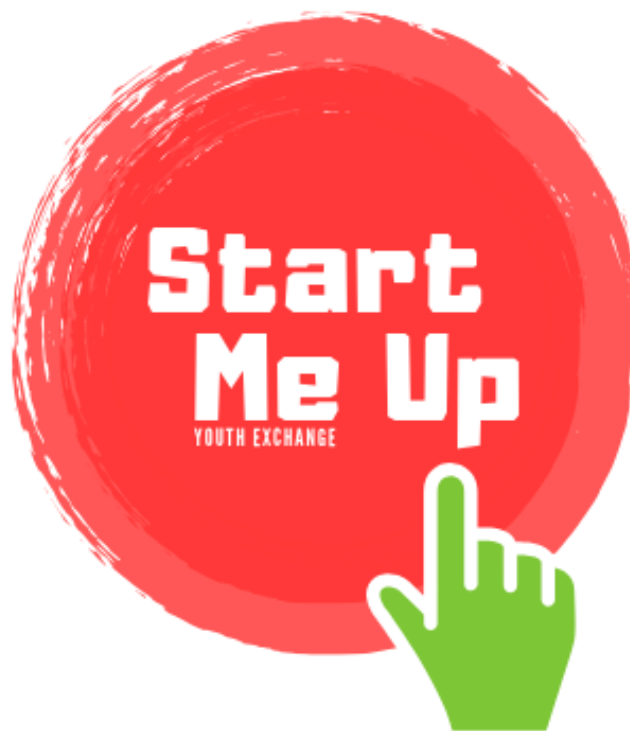

A FEW THINGS ABOUT THE PROJECT:

The highest unemployment rates in the EU are those of young people and, in some countries, this percentage exceeds 50%. An important cause of the high unemployment rate is the lack of a life skills provision from the school system. It is now clear, as the G20 leaders say, that employment can be increased by encouraging entrepreneurship. StartMeUp is a youth exchange program focusing on the issue of youth unemployment and entrepreneurship as a way out of unemployment. It will take place in Kalamata, Greece and will invite 36 young people for 7 days from 6 different countries to:



- 1) Learn the importance of entrepreneurial spirit in personal development.
- 2) Develop pro-energy, self-confidence in public speeches and problem-solving ability.
- 3) Get the operational tools and knowledge needed to implement business ideas.
- 4) Learn behavioural interactions and recognize their own results in a working environment.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

The young people who will participate in the exchange will be from Italy, Romania, Portugal, Croatia, Lithuania and Greece. Five young people and one leader will participate from each country. The youngsters will be between 18 and 30 years of age, while the leaders over 18 without an upper limit.



Also, at least half of the young people will be unemployed and there will be a balance between the number of women and men.

The key objective of the program is to make a positive contribution to reducing youth unemployment in the EU by focusing on entrepreneurial skills, also increasing the chances of young people to implement innovative ideas.

The purpose of the project is to:

- 1) Understand that entrepreneurship is a viable way to combat youth unemployment.
- 2) Develop a sense of initiative and entrepreneurship and self-esteem.
- 3) Identify the various obstacles that young people can face and learn how to overcome them.
- 4) Shape or improve their attitudes, knowledge and skills in the working environment.
