Important notes

- Try to find the most economical way of traveling. Book the tickets as soon as possible. Tickets should be booked by the partner organization.
- To reimburse travel expenses, European Youth Educational Centre Magdeburg needs the ORIGINAL travel documents with date, location (from where to where), name of the traveler and price visible.
- E-Tickets/-Invoices must be accompanied by proof of payment. Missing tickets will not be reimbursed. Travel expenses will only be reimbursed up to the actual amount payable.
- The organizers will not provide any additional accommodation outside the dates of the exchange! If you wish to travel on other dates than the dates of the exchange, please take contact with the organizers before purchasing your tickets.
