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Starting point

WE CAME TO THE IDEA OF THIS TRAINING COURSE DISCUSSING THE DIFFICULTY OF MOTIVATING AND INVOLVING YOUTH IN DIFFERENT PROJECTS AMONGST OUR PARTNERS. WE NOTICED THAT TRADITIONAL APPROACHES TO INVOLVE YOUTH IN ERASMUS + DO NOT NECESSARILY WORK BEST WHEN IT COMES TO THEM ALTHOUGH THEY HAVE THE MOTIVATION TO BE PART OF IT.

THEN WE CREATED OUR PARTNERSHIP CONSORTIUM AND CARRIED OUT OUR DAILY METHODS OF WORK AND WHAT CAN WE CHANGE TO MAKE IT BETTER. WE CONCLUDED THAT YOUNG PEOPLE NEED TO EXPERIENCE A DYNAMIC APPROACH FOR INCLUSION, WHICH THEY CAN HAVE THROUGH INTERACTIVE WAYS OF PARTICIPATION

What is Funded



The project is funded by the Erasmus + programme of the European Union. It means that costs related to participants' international and local travel, accommodation, food and activities will be covered.

For the travel costs please use the distance calculator of E+

And the budget list of E+ according to the distance, be aware of the fact that around 35 euro will be used for the transport from the airport to the venue and back.

Venue



Probably:

1 eight persons and one six persons stone house (adapted) with if needed 2 extra mattresses

6 x fishermans cottage (6 beds)

What to pack

- Rain clothes - Umbrella

- One day you will be responsible for the cooking together with another country :) details will follow later.

How to get to Bant

1. EASY WAY

We will arrange a bus from Schiphol (Amsterdam airport) to the venue to pick you up from the airport on 11 nov around 20.00

We will arrange a bus from the venue to Schiphol (Amsterdam airport) to bring you back to the airport on 21 nov around 6.00

Then you need to book your tickets accordingly of course, if there are slight differences in time we will adapt the hours. (if you have many waiting hours then you can go (on your own expenses) to Amsterdam in your waiting time, it is 15 min by train directly from the airport)

The meeting point in the airport is in the arrival hall and is close to the burger king, now it is just a small billboard on a stick (not the cube anymore)

2. HARD WAY

You can fly on every available airport in the Netherlands, and from there travel by train. (Amsterdam is the most convenient, but Eindhoven will do also)

You can travel by train to Lelystad central station (from every airport) it will cost you 1-3 hours, from there you taken the bus to Emmeloord and from Emmeloord you take the bus to Bant, then it is about 5 km walking (if possible we will pick you up)

You can book the train tickets quit easy online on www.ns.nl , you can switch to English, you book 2nd class, no discount one way tickets, so one one-way ticket for coming and one for going J, in the Netherlands we don't have fixed seats in the train and also you can use the train ticket all day long. So there is no fixed time. You can also go out and back in, so you can go from Schiphol to Amsterdam central and go a few hours to the city and then go back in the train and go to Lelystad. we calculate them of course for the travel costs.
