OBJECTIVE

The project will consist of a training course dedicated to youth workers and aimed to develop competencies in using non-formal education methods for the promotion of youth mental health.

In the training participants will increase their knowledge and the understanding of:

- mental health as a positive resource and skill that youth workers could teach, learn, support, and strengthen
- tools to promote the mental health of young people
- how to raise a concern with a young person, how to support them and to find help if necessary
- how a youth worker can have an important role in the promotion of mental health
- how to plan and develop youth organizations to support the mental well-being of young people

ACCOMODATION

In Zadar you will be staying at hotel Donat. Here is the link to the hotel website: www.hoteldonat.com/. The address is: Majstora Radovana 7, Zadar, 23 000 Croatia.

Participants will be accommodated in double rooms. If someone needs a single room, he has to pay the difference in price himself.





GETTING TO THE HOTEL

If you arrive to Zagreb airport (Franjo Tuđman airport) by plane and want to take a bus to Zadar:

At the Zagreb airport you can find bus for the central Zagreb Bus Station. One-way ticket is 8 euro and you can buy the ticket in the bus. Departures are scheduled every 30 minutes

during the day, from 6.00 to 21.00. Trip duration: 35-40 minutes, time table can be found HERE.

From Central Bus Station you can take bus to Zadar (time table and one way prices are available at http://www.akz.hr/EN/voznired.aspx.

Prices are different and the duration of journey varies of the way. Express line is around 3 hours, some other lines which are not taking the highway could take up to 5 hours. When you arrive to Zadar by bus, follow instructions "If you arrive to Zadar by bus".

If you arrive to Zadar by bus:

In front the Central Bus Station building, on the main road, there are stations for local bus lines. (Public transportation company Liburnija operates from 5 am till 11.15 pm). You have bus /every 20 - 40 minutes/ from bus station to Borik (part of town Zadar). It costs 1,59 euro. Ticket could be purchased at the kiosk (newsstand) at the bas stop or in the bus. Hotel Donat is situated at 5 km distance from the bus terminal (take bus line no. 5 or no. 8 which brings you straight to the hotel) in the famous Borik tourist zone, that offers many commodities. Tell to the bus driver you are going to Hotel Donat.

Taxi

If you arrive by bus or a plane to Zadar, there is also an option to arrive to Hotel Donat by taxi, especially if you arrive early in the morning or late at night. The price in one direction is around 45 euro from the Airport and around 12 euro from the Bus Station. If you want to take this option in to account, please let us know earlier so that we can arrange it for you.
